Dear Cal State LA Community,

Associated Students, Inc. (A.S.I.) shares a profound disappointment with the Trump administration's decision to rescind the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program (DACA). Through this unnecessary act, the federal government has created a tremendous sense of anxiety and fear, affecting thousands of students on our campus and nationwide. DACA is a tool for Dreamers to achieve their dreams, goals, and aspirations, but now our fellow students, friends, and colleagues fear the repeal of DACA will jeopardize their futures.

Per letters from [Cal State LA University President William A. Covino](#) and [Chancellor Timothy P. White](#), the CSU community and our campus will continue to be supportive of undocumented students and foster a university climate where everyone feels welcome and included.
