#### III. Old Business

- a. Removal of Appointed Members Language in Governing Codes of Procedures The committee will continue reviewing the language regarding removal of appointed members reflected in each Code of Procedures addressing allowable consecutive unexcused absences, unexcused absences, unexcused tardies, or unexcused early departures during any one (1) semester.
  - ➤ Absences and tardies for removal, showing up 15 min late means you are tardy
  - >Limiting all absences to 3 absences whether excused or unexcused
  - ➤ Allowed two excused absences, and one unexcused? Or 3 unexcused—you can only have one unexcused absence (for biweekly meetings)
  - ➤ Need something about consecutive absences—absent for two consecutive excused, the second is automatically unexcused
  - ➤15 min after starting, before meeting ends, three excused tardies or early departures
  - ➤ Maximum 1 unexcused absence, max 1 can be an unexcused early departure or tardy, or if you miss two meetings in a row, you will get a performance review from your direct report,
