# **Club Funding Proposal**

#### I. Summary

Every year ASI allocated a certain part of their operating budget to Student Organization Direct Funding to directly reimburse student organization events that are benefiting the campus climate. These events range from fundraisers to banquets to conference. Over the last 4 years, ASI has seen a steady increase of student organizations utilizing this opportunity. The result of having club funding have been ASI being more well-known with students. A part of the Strategic Plan is finding out more ways to connect to student organizations. #### II. Objective

#### III. Description

The ASI Finance division is requesting additional funds to finish out the year with the remaining funding requests. The Funding Sub-Committee has one more meeting this year on April 27, and ASI only has \$500 left to allocate. If approved, this will prevent ASI from turning down the final funding requests for student events.

#### IV. Management

The ASI Funding Sub-Committee, with the oversight of the ASI Finance Committee, approves and monitors the amount of funds allocated to student organizations. The Funding Sub-Committee submits a report the Finance Committee to finalize the approval process of funding requests.
