#### **History of CSUnity Student Leadership Conference**

Workshop and super sessions will discuss leadership development strategies, communications and marketing, tools to ensure strong governance of a board of directors, and ideas about creating change through representing and advocating on behalf of your student bodies.

#### **Overview of CSUnity**

CSUnity brings CSU student leaders together to receive training, develop skills and network with peers. The conference is most applicable to Associated Students and Student Union executive officers and board members. The 2018 CSUnity Conference is being planned specifically for student leaders in the California State University system.
