- Lily: parking doesn't need a line in the direct funding allocation guideline. Up to the committee's decision and make sure that precedence is held. Ambiguity is fine.
- Chris: parking should be considered under honoraria since it is a service/courtesy for a non-Cal State LA student.
- Lily: option to increase honoraria amount.
- Jacquelyn: where does 560 come from? No one knows.
- Chris: does not support an honoraria raise because of parking permits.
- ♣ Nia J.: raise honoraria because of current parking situation.
- Lily: think about VI.b. and II.d. for next meeting.
