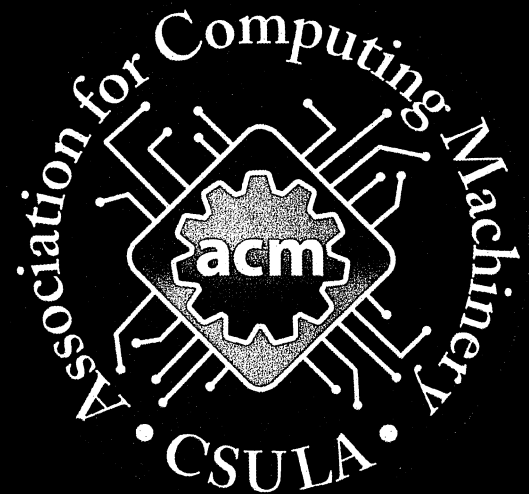

- CONDUCT:** The organization assumes full responsibility for the conduct of participants at the event. Any violation of University policy may subject the participants and/or the organization to disciplinary action by the Center for Student Involvement or Student Conduct.
- ALCOHOL:** In accordance with Administrative Procedure 019 - Alcoholic Beverages, any event (on or off campus) that involves the consumption of alcoholic beverages requires authorization from the University. Additional guidelines may be enforced.

All printed marketing to be used for marketing registered events are required to be stamped by CSI prior to their approved posting. Stamps can be obtained after the event has been registered. 


