### 1. What previous experience have you had in the area in which you are applying for?

In the past, I was a representative for my year in the Early Entrance Program, and I was recently voted in to continue my duties as a sophomore representative. This past year as a freshman at Cal State LA, I served as a representative, where my duties were mainly to serve as a liaison and communication between the executive board of the club and the basic students of my year. I informed my cohort through weekly emails and through social media, and I was able to ease in social groups within the Early Entrance Program to create a collaborative space for all students. I attended weekly meetings to discuss issues and events within our program for the wellbeing of students. I was able to very easily assimilate and learn how to communicate more effectively. I became involved with the club, as I designed the logo and was able to efficiently compromise with the PR team in our club.

In the past, before I came to the Early Entrance Program here at Cal State LA, I was in major clubs at my high school. I was a freshman student council at Cleveland Charter High, where I was the treasurer. I was in charge of freshman fundraisers and kept account of the funds for the 9th grade cohort. I helped with the fundraisers myself, and was very active within the freshman activities. I sat in many meetings, and was able to speak on behalf of the specialized Humanities Magnet that I was apart of.

Another high school club I was active in was the COREdinators club. It was a club specifically geared to the humanities magnet kids and helping all years to socialize and develop better communication skills. In COREdinators, I served as the 9th grade representative. I served to represent the entirety of the freshmen in the program, and assimilate both the freshman and upper years. I was able to easily hold my cohort accountable to the rules of the club and to deadlines like fee payments, turning in attendance sheets, and keeping all grades in contact with each other.

I am interested in applying for this position because I want to bring more insight about issues from the College of Business and Economics.
