# What previous experience have you had in the area in which you are applying for?

While I have never been involved in student government, I have always been an advocate for students' rights and needs. Having worked as the Community Outreach Coordinator with CaSIG, I have successfully organized, developed, and executed a Cal State LA Career Connector that created community for students, provided students an opportunity to network, find jobs, and volunteer opportunities. In preparation for this event, I implemented multiple survey models to target students' needs directly. More recently, I have been working with CaSIG to build a peer-to-peer student advising service where students can schedule a 15 minute zoom or text appointment to request resources, express their concerns, or get peer guidance. I developed this program because I feel passionate about advocating for students' needs and feel strongly about listening to student voices. With this model, students would be able to call and share their needs. Student's voices would then follow a chain of command that makes sure it funnels to administration so that they can create policy to better help students; creating an ecosystem to help resolve student concerns.

# State briefly why are you are applying and/or are interested in this position

I am applying for this position because I want to be an advocate for Graduate students at CSULA. I am eager to make a difference in my Cal State LA community by taking on an active role in student government. I believe I have the drive, motivation, and determination to create policies that will benefit present and future Graduate Students, making Cal State LA a more desirable destination for completing a Master Degree. My highly developed organizational, communication, and multitasking skills would be effective at fulfilling the outcomes of the Graduate Academic Senator.

# What do you feel are some of the major problems facing the students of Cal State LA?

The greatest issues that students at Cal State LA are facing is financial strain, concerns about safety, and emotional stress and anxiety. Many student's places of work have foreclosed, while students who did not lose their job entirely still experienced payment cuts and a limitation of hours. Financial stress and insecurity can lead to mental health issues, anxiety, and stress which is also a major problem for Cal State LA students. The emotional stress students experience will doubtlessly appear in the classroom, hindering college experience and performance. Furthermore, there have been concerns from students about the quality of safety provided at CSULA. It is therefore important to implement measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19 to make sure students feel safe to return to campus.

# List activities and/or organizations that you have been involved with (on or off campus)

During my senior year of Undergraduate studies, I was the Community Outreach Manager for the on campus group CaSIG (Civic and Social Innovation Group), I coordinated a Social Impact Career Connector event to build relationships between students and partner organizations. In 2019, I partnered with the non-profit organization Slate-Z as a GIS Tech Analyst. I conducted research to develop an innovative strategy that supported local business owners and entrepreneurs in South LA. I used GIS tech to map problems in South LA, co-designed an initiative to implement positive social change, and composed a funding proposal. In my spare time I play weekend event with my Mariachi Group.
