What previous experience have you had in the area in which you are applying for?

I have previously served as an Undergraduate Academic Senator in ASI. I have experience advocating for student interests to a faculty-majority body, and advocating for student interests to administration. As a representative on the Senate Fiscal Policy Committee, I have a keen understanding of how budgeting can be prioritized to align with students' best interests and how issues like mental health support and facility maintenance ultimately must be addressed at a fiscal level. I also have experience holding ASI events, like the International Fair and the Student Resource Fair, which allow students to find communities on campus and to get involved.

State briefly why are you are applying and/or are interested in this position

Last year, recruiting students for ASI external committees and helping them find their voice for leadership was something I was very passionate about. I would like to continue doing that as a Senator and empower student voices when it comes to systemic issues as well. I would like to address issues such as overpolicing and systemic barriers to education access that affect our students. Cal State LA serves many non-traditional college students, who may not have had the same opportunities and privileges compared to many other college students. Cal State LA serves a diverse community of first generation students, returning students, students of color, and incarcerated students. This is one of the finest attributes of our Cal State LA community, but I believe there is still work to be done. Many of our students belong to minority groups that have been and continue to be systemically oppressed, whose voices have long been silenced. As a Senator, I would like to enact policy and fiscal changes that would reflect the concerns and interests of our students, and continue to further Cal State LA's mission of upward mobility and educational opportunities for everyone.

What do you feel are some of the major problems facing the students of Cal State LA?

I would like to empower students to realize that they can be advocates and leaders for the issues they care about, from banning tuition hikes and prioritizing mental health to educational inequality and facility accessibility. There continue to be barriers to our students' access to education. I would like to dismantle things like tuition hikes, overpolicing, and overdue facility maintenance that makes class inaccessible to students with disabilities. In this time, it is also crucial to support students' basic needs, then their academic needs, and then foster a sense of community. This begins with ensuring our students have access to food, shelter, and healthcare- including mental health. Then we can ensure students have access to electronic devices, wifi, and textbooks to support them academically. Finally, we can foster community through the first two actions and by empowering students to participate in serving and advocating for their needs. As Senator, I want to fill as many student representative committee seats as possible. I would like to provide actionable things that students with concerns are able to do. I believe this would allow us to most faithfully represent students' top interests, and further empower students by giving them avenues where they can be leaders for the issues they're passionate about - part of ASI's mission.
