I also noticed that CAPS is inaccessible in some way because a person is required to attend three workshops before going to a full 45-minute therapy session and I feel that needs to change and improved so students can get utilize the Student Health Center more properly. I wish there was also more advocacy for FGLI students (first-generation and or low-income students) and more awareness for EOP which targets FGLI students since as an FGLI student myself, I wish it was more visible and expands by having more resources and support for FGLI students.

I am currently doing a work internship through the Youth@Work program at a non-profit organization called In The Making which is a non-profit community center in which I able to participate in volunteering in food drives/banks and collaborating with team members by sorting out clothing donations for the community center's boutique.
