IV. Discussion Items

- 3. Seed money allocation proposal
 - a. Tyler was presenting a 300 dollar seed funding proposal given to all recognized student organizations for the fall semester of 2021.
 - b. There was discussion regarding submitting several documents in order to get the seed funding but it was later agreed to do a google form and just make clubs fill it out before receiving the funds.
 - c. Then the form was going to show what the clubs will use the funding form so ASI can have a record of their purchases.
 - d. The proposal is now moved to the finance committee in order to be discussed and get approval.
- 4. University Council of Clubs and Organizations
 - a. Discussing revisions to ASI polices in order to make it easier for student orgs to read and updating some minor language within the document to the current policies and ASI status.
- 5. Direct Funding Guidelines, Equipment and Clothing
 - a. The Equipment policy was fully discussed if clubs should own equipment bought using ASI policy which will making equipment requests from clubs easier to get approved.
 - b. There was several arguments regarding this because of safety procedures within the equipment, also storage space within ASI which they needed to track each item, and the idea of clubs throughout different generations ordering the same piece of equipment.
 - c. The Committee decide to let the equipment policy be sharpen up later and make equipment be a responsibility towards the student org's college representatives.
 - Also the Clothing policy was also in discussion where we replace the \$7.85 dollars purchasing amount that ASI would fund for each shirt to 80% of the shirt's cost, this change was made because of the current economic status and shirt prices going up in the years.
