State briefly why are you are applying and/or are interested in this position

What do you feel are some of the major problems facing the students of Cal State LA?

As such, I think it is critical to strengthen the relationship between students and administrators through events such as townhalls as well as upkeeping a frequent communication line. The second major issue I believe students face is the lack of promotion the university does for its resources. The university offers incredibly helpful resources such as the food pantry, free career development tools, and so forth, but a relatively small niche of students are aware of them. Therefore, I think we need to better promote the resources our school offers so that students can use them to their benefit.
