## III. Discussion Items

- a. ASI Sustainability Policy (Policy 019)
  - Sasha shared about the ASI Sustainability Guidelines (Policy 019), which is outdated and no longer relevant. As such, it has been suggested to either revise the guidelines or to propose a resolution. Ryan had ideas about tracking ASI sustainability and setting goals for ASI to move towards sustainability. The EPC can modify the code of procedures to allow EPC to set goals for ASI to move towards sustainability. A resolution would be more permanent and establish long-term goals while a change in the code of procedures would allow EPC to set short-term goals. To edit the code of procedures, it would take a week of discussion, a week of action, and then corresponding with the justices. Sasha has suggested for the committee to scrap policy 019 and

to edit the committee's code of procedures (Policy 012) Article 1 (Authority and Function) to add the power of setting goals for ASI to move towards sustainability.
