- ➤ Addressing Student Needs Webinar Reflection- The committee will discuss areas of improvements to continue effective advocacy.

 - Angelina Gomez: Angelina shares her experience in the webinar as she enjoyed it and thought it was informative.

 - Diana Chavez: Diana shares that it is difficult to do that at the end of the semester and information and what the director

- Diana Chavez: Diana reminds the committee that Gus sent out an email regarding spring programming and that they are

 scenarios.

- Diana Chavez: Diana shares that she was thinking about doing campus tours.
- Amber Beasley: I think have snacks and coffee and having somewhere to congregate and get to know each other will help. Amber also shares her opinion on the survey.
- Diana Chavez: Diana takes everyone's ideas in mind and shares the difficulty in some of these ideas like retreat.
- Angelina Gomez: I think that offering swag gear is a good incentive.
- Diana Chavez: Diana shares that getting more swag would be an issue because the money being used should be going to the students.
- Angelina Gomez: Angelina shares her opinion about the student body being upset about purchasing ASI gear and wasting students' money.
