This report indicates the spending break-down of Project Rebound Cal State LA of funding received from ASI for the Fall 2020 semester. During the pandemic our formerly incarcerated student population has endured some additional financial barriers. As explained in our funding proposal, the formerly incarcerated community has experienced housing insecurity, food insecurity, transportation limitations and connectivity to internet. It is for this reason that the ASI funding has been instrumental in the success of our students. Several students found it difficult to access funding through the accounts created at the campus bookstore within the allotted timeframe, due to inconsistency of the campus bookstore hours. Others attend classes in the evenings and do not arrive on campus until after campus bookstore closes. Project Rebound has decided to reopen these accounts for students to regain access to the funds they were promised this Fall 2021 and intends to seek out all options possible to mitigate this in the future. A break-down of the ASI funding expenditure is provided below.
