a. January 2024 Financials

Page 2 of 3 Finance Committee Meeting Thursday, February 15, 2024 Dena: Transparent about the 2024 January Financials and explains that ASI is on a trailer system, so our budget is based on the revenues we collected last year. This year to date, we received a check for \$630,000. This will be a kickoff to our 24-25 budget. For the personnel expenses, you'll see the budget, the year-to-date costs in the middle column, what's available left to spend, and a percentage on the farright column. The use of reserves will change because you've already approved this budget so the use of reserves will go down.

• Andrew Klein: Shares that he has had a few conversations with Barnaby and Dena about next year's budget and the planning process for that. For the SCORE Program, he is looking forward to seeing the numbers and what impact there will be compared to the previous program. He hopes that the foundation can provide additional funding.

• Shreyas: Explains that he is looking forward to having more events where clubs are educated about the funding process. He is also eager to see the impact of SCORE.

• Barnaby Peake: He will reach out to the library to get the statistics on SCORE from what ASI funded. The 6&6 moves to the board for final approval next week. For next year's budget, there will be a decrease in out fee revenue so that is a big topic of conversation.
