Arwa: Mentioned that the Committee could do half of the funding, and with the other half, there

could be possible funding resources from another department on campus.

Diana: Asked if there is an alternative food truck that the Committee could suggest for the event.

River: Answered that there would need to be more research on a specific food truck (maybe a donut food truck)?

Gennesis: Mentioned that there should be a funding cap on how the Committee could spend money on events from other departments.
