- a. Elections Codes and Procedures-The committee will discuss the suggested changes to the elections process.
  - > Samuel Han: We are looking at our elections policy to see if they need to be updated for this coming elections. We are looking at other CSU's to see how they do it.
  - Alejandro: I also looked at UC Bearky's policy as well.
  - Malik: I sent Intef an e-mail and I will send one to you. I looked at Sacramento State and we can have the bylaws and things accessible online. They have a maximum and a minimum to how much they spend on the campaign. They keep track cuz they get the receipts
  - > Samuel Han: what if they get money from outside sources?
  - Felipe: If they get money from an outside source then that is included into their maximum.
  - > Samuel: How would we know how much they spent?
  - Intef: We cannot look into their accounts it is what they report. We should see how it is they campaign. If the posters are super glossy and in color.
  - > Samuel: We should take into consideration what DR. Adamian said. That we should not be the police force for the elections.
  - Intef: We don't have to be. That is what the elections committee is for
  - > Samuel: Is that per individual or slate
  - ➤ Malik: I am not sure?
  - Samuel: Oh we have a maximum and a slate maximum
  - Letycia: To play devil's advocate, what if the person has a family member that does prints?
  - Intef: They have to count the donation as part of their campaign money

- > Samuel: Is there anything we found when it comes to Sacramento State?
- ➤ Malik: Well I have something from Northridge about the size of flyers. That the flyers have to be 8 1/2 by 11.
- Samuel Han: We have a policy in regards to posters and not in regards to flyers.
- Alejandro: If we were to come up with a point system. If they have too many flyers to then the other candidate may not have a place to post. So, the one flyer to post then the other candidates can post.
- Frances: When I saw the University of Washington one, they have a website dedicated to the elections process and they have two elections committee due to their large student body.
- ➤ Alejandro: I like that idea too.
- Felipe: CSUN has elections employees that they call a street team.
- ➤ Intef: I like the University of Washington idea that they have volunteers.
- Samuel Han: Malik just send me what you write down and send me to them.
- ➤ Intef: We should focus on the grievance process and the JRC. When it comes to grievances we cannot be vague in the policy.
- Frances: what do we do when it comes to taking down campaign stuff?
- ➤ Intef: That is to be determined.
- > Frances: There was the CSU San Diego they have a \$100 deposit to take down their campaign material.
