 C. The Shared Governance committee reviewed the Shared Governance Committee pamphlet created
 by Nicholas Carillo and Intef W. Weser.
- Intef W.Weser explained the document for shared Governance. There were suggestions regarding the document and Magali Espinoza asked for a table of contents. Manuel Rodriguez asked for a description to identify Administration Committee.

IV. Discussion

Shared Governance Budget

The Committee discussed the best use of the Shared Governance budget. There were suggestions that were made during the meeting. Nicholas Carrillo explained that there will be \$3,000.00 per year allotted to the budget. There were suggestions that were made during the discussion. Sophia Biggs suggested Committee kits for new committee members. Manuel Rodriguez explained how there should be marketing incentives for students for students. Alina Carmona suggested e-mailing professors to provide extra credit for students who join a committee. Intef Weser then suggested that there should be 2 graduate mixers, while Lisa Vittayarukskul suggested that there should be a committee mixer planned this school year in order to get more students involved. However, Magali Espinoza expressed that the most important thing that ASI members need to remember is that the student's interests on the committees come first. Uriel Serrano then explained that ASI members need to explain to interested students of how joining a committee will build your resume.

V. Reports

a. Risk management & Safety Committee- Eric Lozick

Made a proposal in regards to public safety. He proposed that there may be written instructions posted in classrooms of what exactly to do in case of an emergency. If anyone in ASI is interested to contact him or if anyone may be interested in joining him with writing the proposal to let him know.

b. Undergraduate Academic Senator – Manuel Rodriguez

Discussed the issues that were mentioned in Academic Senate Committee. He explained that there were bills that were not signed by Cal State La President Covino. One of those amendments that were not signed was Final examinations. Kevin Rodriguez, in response, explained that a faculty member explained that no one really goes by the rules and regulations unless the issue is brought up in the Academic grievance committee.

c. Graduate Academic Senator – Carmen Avalos

Carmen discussed the graduate Dean meeting and explained that the meeting went well. She also explained the graduate mixer and the turnout was a success.

d. Graduate Academic Senator - Uriel Serrano

Uriel discussed more information regarding the Academic Senate meeting. He explained more information in regards to another bill that was not signed by President Covino in regards to the EOP Priority Registration. He explained that President Covino would only sign the bill if the bill allowed for first year freshman EOP students to register. There were questions that were brought to the discussion in the amount of students that the school will allow for EOP students currently and how many are actually available. The conflict that the members realized that if all EOP students were allowed to priority registration, then it would defeat the purpose of priority registration. The EOP discussion was then added in the next meeting to vote on.

e. Undergraduate Academic Senator – Dennia Palmer

Dennia Palmer explained some of the issues that were discussed in the Student Policy

Committee. She explained that there were several issues that were addressed during the meeting besides student who are in EOP. One of the issues that were discussed was food and why Dolcini Café was closed down. She also explained that the faculty members of the Student Policy committee really appreciated the Farmer's market event and would like to have that event happen more often. She said that she would speak to the College Representatives who hosted the event and possibly have the event again next quarter. Another item that was discussed was in regards to the parking situation. She explained that because students are having difficulty finding parking, that students are parking in the staff parking spots which are creating problems because faculty cannot find parking.

f. Alcohol & Drug Awareness Committee – Sean Weerasignhe

Sean discussed some of the upcoming events that are going to be going on this Fall quarter. He explained that there will be a conference at UC Riverside that would talk about some ways to be able to inform people about drug & alcohol abuse. Explained how there is a connection between drug and alcohol abuse with domestic violence. He also explained that he would like to start a program similar to AA where people can meet and discuss some of the issues that they are facing relating to drug and alcohol issues. He also explained that he did not want this to be forced upon people, but to offer it for those who are willing to participate in these meetings. He also explained that he and Lily Tran are trying to find a way for students who are intoxicated or under the influence to have a specific room at the dorms for them to sober up so that they do not create disturbance or harm to others
