The proposed revisions distinguish the two, provide a function and provide a stronger direction for academic senators and committees members to take. Cecilia asked what the quorum of the committee would like since as of now all of the committee members are voting members.

Nicholas commented that he is looking at a couple options to address the issue. One could be having each committee area delegate a few voting members. We could have only the
