- c. Administrative Assistant II Position Allocation The Finance Committee will take action on Personnel Committee recommendation to fund a student assistant position to assist with front desk coverage and several expanding administrative tasks.
- Dena explained that this position would assist in coverage of work, accounting in particular. It would be a 20 hour a week position and the student would preferably be an accounting major, however it is also very open to hiring from

- within ASI as a promotion. This position entails helping with paper work (possibly club funding) which would allow other staff to get other things done quicker.
- Shane Vera clarified that the need for the position was approved in the personnel committee; the next step would be for the finance committee to approve the funding for it.
- Antonio Canzona questioned which part of the budget is being cut in order to allocate the money for the position.
- Intef Weser explained that there is enough allocated money in the administrative budget line item left over to fund this position for the rest of this year. We will be pulling unspent money from the GIA vacancies.
- Antonio Canzona asked about the process of choosing a candidate for the position.
- Intef Weser explained that it would be led by a committee made up of student staff and governing officers to post the position and recruit.
- Antonio Canzona asked and was clarified that once this is approved by the finance committee, it will be sent to the next BOD meeting and the searching process will take place immediately.
