b. 6 & 6 Budget - The Finance Committee will review and approve the 6 & 6 Budget of A.S.I.

- Carina Kan went through the 6 & 6 budget, and gave brief overviews of changes mentioned in the packet.
- There were increases to staff and student salaries for wage increases and promotions to more demanding positions.
- Travel increases since there were more people sent to conferences.
- Student Club and Org Funding increase since many more clubs than expected are asking for funding for events and banquets. (this money was pulled from the Capital equipment & Loss of Disposal of Fix Assets line item, instead of paying off the 0% interest loan with 200% of the minimum payment, 100% will be paid instead).
- Committee member vouchers increase (Instead of \$90 a quarter, committee members will receive \$100), for better
 incentivizing more students to join committees and a better reward for participating in ASI and attending the
 meetings.
- There has been discussion of adding a separate line item for Club/Org banquet funding, instead of having it under Club/Org funding, since banquets have been depleting club funding very quickly.
- Discontent was expressed by the committee about the Arts and Letters College backing out of the deal they had with Golden Eagle Radio about funding half of expenses for starting up after ASI provided the other half.
- Carina Kan informed the committee that CSULA won a contest for the campus with the most Microsoft downloads the Campus emailed Intef about the recent win and due to money issues regarding security for Microsoft's Nick Jonas concert, many departments on campus are chipping in to cover the costs. Intef forwarded the email to me and Shane about ASI putting in a contribution. We agreed and ASI is putting in \$5000 out of the extra money in programming.
- Shane Vera "It's pretty funny how everyone collaborates and chips in for a concert that Microsoft puts on, but when ASI wants to get together and put on a music festival for everyone, no one wants to chip in for ****." "I want that put in the minutes."
