- Duties of college reps outside of the cabinet are different from the general duties of college reps
- Academic senators code includes how to serve as a chair/vice chairs
- Compare cabinet of academic senators and SGC
- o Required meetings, service hours, responsibilities, duties in the cabinet
 - Refer to different articles already stating stuff instead of creating new language
 - Ensure consistency
 - Read through other articles

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Rongxiang Xu HHS

- 3.A. -Chair for only one semester
 - o Easier and cleaner to have one person for the whole academic year
 - o Principle of letting college reps learn how to chair meetings
- 3.B. -Scheduling meetings once a month
 - o No consultation with chair thus far
- 4 5. -Removal for chair/vice chair
 - o Removal process for college reps?
 - o Recommend removal to exec committee
 - Cite which policy removal process is outlined
- 4 3.A. -Chair responsibilities/changing direct report
 - o Direct reports for all college reps
 - o For
 - Role of the president is to supervise and advise
 - Don't need to manage, delegate responsibilities
 - Reporting to a fellow college rep
 - Comfortable, familiar with responsibilities
 - Better for availability
 - Free up time for president to focus on university-wide goals
 - o Against
 - Needs a chair like Kenya
 - Who has experience, knows what they're doing
 - Group of people choosing their direct report that the committee can remove
 - Weird relationship
 - Conflict of interest
 - Board of director oversees all the other board of directors
 - One college supervising the all the other colleges
 - A lot of work for the chair
 - o Alternatives
 - Another executive to oversee cabinet
 - Chair oversees inter-collegiate activities
 - Need to establish relationship between college rep and president
 - All execs are committee chairs but not all committee chairs are execs
 - o Reports

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- Electronic reports 72 hours in advance
- BOD has codes about absences and stuff
 - Missing amount of meeting to be absent
 - Currently reviewing in JRC
- Cabinet of academic senators
 - Reviewing policies to make the committee more productive
 - Something that could come out of this committee to be approved by BOD
 - Adding another set of responsibilities to produce things to send to the BOD
 - Maybe adding language to open the CCR as a starting place for things to go to the BOD
 - More friendly environment than BOD
 - Make new people aware that this is a power they can recognize
 - Want clear language about who to go to and what the process is to write a resolution
 - CCR for feedback or as a starting place to send up to BOD?
 - As a cabinet we agree that this is an important resolution and should be sent to the next governing body
 - Another responsibility for a chair; helping college reps with resolutions

- Chair can facilitate something the whole cabinet thinks is important
- Don't put it in policy, just pass it to the next people in our transition folders
- What is a resolution
 - Needs to be specific language of what resolutions are and what the process is
 - Resolve: action ASI takes once the BOD approves
 - o If the BOD approves this, this is what ASI will do
 - Goes to Legislative Affairs \rightarrow BOD
 - Chair should send an email to pro staff about training for resolutions
- o Language for connection between college reps and senators
 - Add into membership as non-voting members
 - Already written in senator codes
 - Redefining SGC
 - Originally supposed to be a space for communication between reps and senators
 - Need to define what different committees do
 - This is supposed to be happening in this body already
 - Senators want to hear about student problems, not just the programs we're planning
 - Opportunities for college reps to focus our work on what problems students have
 - College reps will be able to sit in cabinet of academic senators

b. Discussion Item: Cabinet of College Representatives 2018/2019 budget/financial standing.

 Proposal

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- o CCR funds -Pool that people can dip into or proposals being brought to cabinet (\$3000)
- -
- Why not bothD-stress
 - o Giant games came from cabinet pool of money since everyone would use it
- Specific language in codes needed
 - Co-college initiatives indicate pulling from pool
 - Single college need indicates the need for a proposal to the CCR
 - In practice
 - New article in codes for budgeting and responsibilities
- Extra funds for each individual college (\$3500)
 - Better opportunity to use CCR pool together
 - College reps creating individual budgets at the beginning of the year
 - College reps drop out all the time
 - More money lets people think bigger
 - Certain colleges have staple events
- Increasing pool and maintaining individual amounts
 - Better fiscal responsibility
 - Go through whole process to get money to do their event
 - Seed money for college reps but proposals for more funding from cabinet
 - Frequency of college rep meetings
 - Chair should schedule meetings monthly
 - Biweekly?
 - Planning things pretty far in advance
 - For things that you didn't expect/budget for
 - Not going to have a ton of proposals at every meeting
 - Need language for calling emergency meetings
- c. Discussion Item: ASI Sponsored Club events: The Cabinet will discuss strategies on attending College-Specific Club events – David Zitser
 - Having ASI attend club events approved by Funding Sub-Committee
 - Can be counted as service hours
 - Newsletter
 - o Contact Communications Director of college to send out emails about ASI
