Christopher Koo: Quickly gives a recap on the budget.

Jocelyn and Dr.Miller - send money to DREAMERS to help undocumented since they don't get CARES Act funds Dena – Would like to see some sort of stipulation so clubs don't have it just sitting around Jorge – Still up \$88K Motion: Jorge-Jocelyn - Amendment to include 50K for student scholarships (Emergency Grant) [ 8-3-0 ] Jocelyn – could increase funding for other initiatives like the food pantry? Chris – don't think there is need for it

Dena – deadline for scholarships were Jan 31, so scholarships wont be available till 2020-2021

- **a.** CARES ACT Funding The Board will discuss the Federal Funding Cal State LA will receive and its plan on allocation and processes.
  - ➤ Joceline Rivera Meeting with Exec Officers of CSSA, some CSU's to get the allocation by Friday or beginning of the week. Funding might mostly only be available next semester, so it won't help too much. If students got tuition fully paid for, would be considered at the later end. Looking at stats before COVID19. Would probably be able to help about \$1K \$1.5K.
  - ➤ Diana Clarification on how it would be distributed to financial aid
  - >Dr.Miller would try to provide step by step instructions to help students get it
  - ➤ Diana \$18/19M for. Heard Cal State LA would get \$37M
  - > Joceline/Dr.Miller don't know which people are participating in the distributing the money
- **b.** Universal Grading Resolution The Board will discuss a resolution submitted by graduate students.
  - > Jafet COVID19 putting lots of change in situations (labs, environments, ...), making it hard to get A's
  - > Alejandro Grad students not needing a P/NP since it looks odd and might be told to retake it
  - ➤ Ivan Minority student's not having the same access. This resolution is for those students that have to deal with stressful situations.
  - > Ledi International students that don't retain the same mental capacity despite having the same resources
  - ➤ Jafet resources aren't the same for students. A lot of applying to things, but hard to do so
  - ➤ Ginny Echoing students on having to combat the pandemic emotionally.
  - > Joceline visual learner and can't learn seeing screen with professor just leading on just to fill his agenda
