

Eagles Electrify Dance Competition Rules and Procedures

Eagles Electrify Dance Competition serves to promote student talent within Cal State LA.

- The contest is open to all currently enrolled students in good standing at Cal State LA.
- The top 3 competitors will receive visa gift card prizes of 1st \$500, 2nd \$300, and 3rd \$200.
- Members participating within the competition must be representing a recognized club or organization on campus.
- Within group performances, all members must be an active member of the club or organization they are representing.
- Clubs and organizations are permitted to work together to form a group.
- Individuals representing a club or organization are able to perform.
- All dance styles are welcome to participate within this event.
- Performers are free to choose which genre of music, if any, they will perform to. Any racist or obscene gestures are not permitted within each performance. Those who violate campus policy are subject to elimination from the competition.

Auditions:

- Auditions will be held on October 25th 7pm-9pm and October 26th 6pm-8pm on the main court of the University Gym.
- Judges for the auditions will be ASI or CSI student members.
- All performances will be judged according to skill and creativity.
- Performances should not last more than 5 minutes.

Competition:

- Those who successfully pass auditions will be automatically qualified for competition day.
- Competition day will be held inside the USU-Theatre on November 29th from 6pm to 8pm. Doors will open at 5pm.
- Rehearsal days inside the USU-Theatre are scheduled on Nov 27th or 28th at 6pm??? (Check with USU if available)
- The capacity of the USU-Theatre is 191. Pre-event tickets will be free, and space will be given to non-ticket holders.
- Performers **are allowed** to change and modify their routine and music for competition day.
- Clubs and organizations **are allowed** to bring in new people who did not participate during the auditions.
