## Commissioners

- **Change Civic Engagement At-large to “Public Service Commissioner”**
  - Position will no longer be an elected Board member, shift to appointed
  - Reporting to the VPEA
  - Office hours rather than engagement hours
  - Committees
    - Serving on Legislative Affairs and Advocacy as Vice Chair, voting
    - Executive Cabinet?
  - **Duties**
    - track BOT meetings
    - follow LA City Council
    - County of LA issues
    - informing student body of issues (Substack?)
    - focus on broader advocacy outside of campus
    - work on the ASI Advocacy Agenda
    - help with recruitment of students at-large to serve on the committee
    - preparations and training for CHES
- **Change Diversity and Inclusion At-large to “D&I Commissioner”**
  - Position will no longer be an elected Board member, shift to appointed
  - Reporting to VPUA
  - Office hours rather than engagement hours
  - Committees
    - Serving on Shared Governance Council as Vice Chair
    - Executive Cabinet?
  - **Duties**

- Connect with student service centers to promote strong inclusion – OSD, Rise, CCC, DREAMers, Veterans, grad, student parents, etc.
  - Collaboration with campus DEIB office
  - Coordinate with PAGE and those students too
  - Advise and suggest ways ASI can be more inclusive in our practices and programs
- **Engagement Commissioner**
  - Named Vice Chair of CEO

#### **Other Notes:**

- Budget allocation – maintain current GIA for commissioners as all college reps
- Removing 2 at-large reps from BOD results in 13 total voting members, odd number is preferred so there is no tie

### **Executive Officer Roles**

- Change Chief of Staff to “Executive Vice President”
  - College reps- Direct Report
  - Committees
    - Chair Executive Cabinet meetings
    - Chair Personnel Committee meetings
    - Vice Chair for BOD – if President is absent
  - **Duties**
    - Facilitate the transition process of student leaders with staff support
    - Impact report, assessment, evaluation, archives
    - Coordinate work and assignments with all Board members
