III. Information Items

A . CCR Code of Procedure - policy 018

Sophia: Reviewing code of procedures and explaining what the CCR meetings are for and how the college reps meet together and update each other on what the college reps are working on

Barnaby: Explaining that this is a recommended body and that it mostly wont be a recommending body Article two and how it talks about quorum and why its important so that the college reps can come together and work together

Going over information item part B which is about the Vice Chair responsibilities

Sophia: explains that vice chair would be there to help her during role call, take notes

Ashley: Explains that vice chair runs meetings if chair is not able to run meeting

Sophia: Explains how its good to show students when explaining the student fee and the increase as it goes deep into what the fee pays for such as salary, scantrons, bluebooks, events, etc.

Ashley: Asks if the marketing and management section is marketing for referendum

Barnaby: Responds that it's for all ASI but its marketing for student government since most of the fee would go into that

Sophia: Explains where to find the information that states the benefits of the referendum and how it will benefit students. Additionally points out where to find the numbers for this and how it's a good way to inform the students of the ASI history

Ashley: Asks if board voted for fee to go down or if the money conversion brought the fee down

Barnaby: Responds saying that the fee went down since school switched from quarter to semester which removed a term to collect fees

Canela: Asks if we have the history of when it was higher and why

Barnaby: Explains that everything is reported and saved

Ashley: Asks if information gets shredded

Barnaby: Explains that nothing gets deleted but information may be lost in technology transfer

Canela: Expresses that if we can find the minutes of the past meetings that it'll help referendum as we can explain to students that it used to be higher

Ashley: Explains that when we had more money we were able to do more programming which attracted students, but since student headcount went down so did programming which also had us lose students

Barnaby: Explains the student enrollment decline

Canela: talks about a different part of website that speaks about what we provide under the services tab (your voice)

Barnaby: Explains that it's a classroom presentation

Canela: Talks about how the slides just say good things but not necessarily the good things that we do in a way for students to understand things

Barnaby: Recommends that we could put the website information in a language that student would understand

Canela: Gives recommendations on how we can write it down.

Sophia: Explains that the website is still ongoing process

Erick: Asks if there's a part that describes changes of fee

Barnaby: Responds that there will be a page to show the difference

Erick: Asks if this will be showed to SFAC

Barnaby: Responds that it will not and we will update the budget number

C. Vacancy for exec cabinet

Sophia: Asks if there is someone available for exec cabinet and that they will ask college rep

Canela: Will the cabinet position will have to be a college rep

Barnaby: Explains that only a college rep can count for quorum

Sophia: Explains that it's only if someone was interested in switching

Hermoine: Asked if there are any other committees that need more reps

Sophia: There is already two board members in each members

Barnaby: Informs that a committee can have more than two board members

A. Members

1. College of A & L Rep

Canela: Shares that she has met with the Dean, Associate Dean and how she knows different people to get every calendar item. Met with the advisors of the college. Made a flyer to explain how to use Handshake to help students get a job. Shares that there was an African American student that received a full ride scholarship from the deans of the departments when his major was changed without his knowledge which put the scholarship at risk. Students was reprimanded for email and told "you need to watch your tone when talking to me...I gave you the scholarship, and I can take it away". Recommended that students document the story and send recap email.

Erick: Shares that he may help college with conference prep as well as working on canvas

3. College of B & E

Alma: Meeting with different people within her college

Hermione: Tries to find a college rep candidate and met with Dean.
